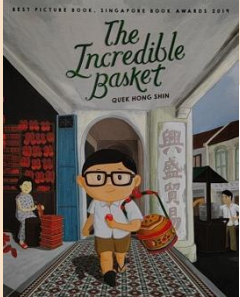

IN THE CLASSROOMS



K2

This term, the children dove into Singapore's history and national symbols through a lively mix of

Kamishibai storytelling, books and engaging visuals. These experiences sparked meaningful conversations about our nation's identity. To wrap up the term, the children will enact scenes from *The Incredible Basket*, a story that celebrates the imagination spirit of childhood play and our diverse heritage. This activity offers children a platform to express their creativity while gaining an appreciation for the ingenuity and resourcefulness of Singapore's early pioneers.



K1

This term, the children have been learning about community helpers - the important roles they play in our neighbourhood and the places where they work. Using cardboard, popsicle sticks, markers and plenty of imagination, the children designed their very own miniature neighbourhoods, complete with roads, vehicles and community helper figures. This experience has made their learning both fun and meaningful.

The children engaged in a fun and meaningful craft activity where they created their own healthy plates. The activity sparked engaging conversations and helped build awareness of healthy eating habits.

In addition to classroom discussions and visual aids, the theme was integrated into music lessons. 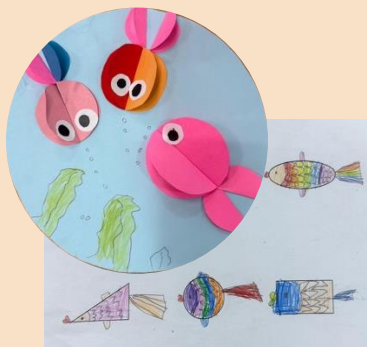
